

## Recent updates (financial)

#### Green Schoolyards

- Request for proposals closed 4/28/2023, 68 applications received requesting a total of \$355 million for projects on 413 campuses.
- \$117 million is available to award.

#### Inflation Reduction Act

- Funding of \$43.2 million from the USDA Forest Service was allocated to CAL FIRE's Urban and Community Forestry Program.
- Expanding Arbor Day programs including Tree City USA, Tree Campus USA, and Tree Line USA
- A request for proposals to select sub-grants is anticipated prior to the end of calendar year 2023.



# Recent updates (policy)

- Statewide strategic plan to increase canopy cover 10% by 2035.
- Legislative discussion about green schoolyards, climate bonds, pocket forests, grant administration, strategic plan for green highways, and California Climate Investments.
- Executive discussion about base funding for Urban and Community Forestry.
- State Hazard Mitigation Plan, extreme heat
- Diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Priority populations and disadvantaged communities
