Arbor Week Poster Contest Rules & Eligibility Guidelines

- The submittal must be original artwork created by California youth ages 5-12
- The artist's first and last name must be written or signed on the front lower right-hand corner of the poster
- The poster must be related to the theme, and the phrase "Trees Root Our Community" must appear somewhere on the poster.
- Artwork must be between 8.5 in. x 11 in. and 11 in. x 17 in. and on a paper that allows for duplication.
- Entry should <u>not</u> be matted, mounted, laminated, framed, or folded.
- Submit artwork along with the Entry Form (below) by 2/7/25 (postmarked) via mail to California ReLeaf at the address provided below. All entries will become the property of California ReLeaf and cannot be returned.
- If you cannot mail the artwork to us, high-quality digital replications (photographs or scans) are eligible. However, if the piece is selected as a finalist, the actual artwork must be sent to California ReLeaf.
